Technology dimension

- Common expectation: the convergence of communication technologies will impact our entire life - also the ESO's and their processes
- Observation: the EU runs two different kind of road mapping processes for standardization (ICT Rolling Plan & Union Work Program) for European ESO's

















Organisational dimension

- Common expectation:
 - whole Europe is based upon the principle of free flow of goods and citizens
 - the human right charter ensures equal rights for everybody at any time
- Observation: the local supervisors, the voters, define different implementation tactics for the local authorities and politicians

















Governance dimension

 Common expectation: standardization can help to organize core political tasks

Observation:

- political principles, like federalism or subsidiarity, prohibit that ESO's or other central organizations do have the necessary empowerment to endorse best practice sharing of local champions
- ESO's are non profit organizations with ongoing financial short comings which determine their agendas
