plena. Na ljubljanskem območju je bober zagotovo živel še v rimski dobi. Sicer je bil v Sloveniji splošno razširjen in verjetno prisoten vsaj do 18. stoletja, ko ga je iztrebil šlovec. Širše v Evropi je bil na pragu izumrtja na začetku 20. stoletja. Zahvaljujoč varstvenim ukrepom in številnim ponovnim naselitvam si je vrsta v 20. stoletju številčno opomogla. Kot poševna naselitev na Hrvaškem se je leta 1998 po namerni poti vrnil k nam. Najprej je po Savi priplaval do

V začetku januarja 2016 je **Jure Cerar**, član Lovske družbe Lukovica, o prisotnosti bobna na reki Rači v širli okolici Domžal obvestil Priradoslovni muzej Slovenije. Ta najdba je presenetljiva, saj je bil doslej bober zabeležen le v spodnjem toku Save do Krškega. Po Savi je torej priplaval vse do mesta izliva Karniške Bistrice južno od Doła pri Ljubljani, nato pa po Bistrici do Rače, ki je levi pritok Karniške Bistrice in se varjo iz-

ves je bilo štrajpati, najdebelejšje je v premeru merilo približno 25 cm. Večinoma so bile tanjše vrbe (*Salix sp.*). Na obravnavanem odseku je bilo največ sledi podtega drevoja na desni brežini v približno 600-metrokem pasu, kjer se ponekod reka razširi do 25 m. Pri prvem ogledu je bilo na desni brežini mogoče opaziti tudi nekaj uglejanih stonin na snežni podlagi. Na celotnem pregledanem območju je reka na najnižjih odsekih široka 4 m, v zajetju pod Gorjuša pa se razširi na 70 m. Tok reke je smirjen, na razširjenih mestih pa so brežine na desnem bregu polobnože in nižje kot na levem. Obrežni pas drevoja je na desnem bregu vsakoli zelo ozek, takoj za njim pa so obdelovalne površine. Na levem bregu so le ponekod manjše gozdne naplate. Od Gorjuše do odcepa za Brezovico pri Dobu poteka lokalna cesta v neposredni bližini levega obrežja. Po navedbah domačinov so znake objedanja opazili že v jeseni 2015. Mogoče je, da se je bober pojavil še pred tem, vendar zaradi vegetacije sledovi niso bili tako vidni. Le-ti so namreč najbolj opazni jeseni in pozimi, ko bober rama na voljo druge hrane in se pohranjuje predvsem z lesnimi nastirami.

Priradoslovni muzej Slovenije se zahvaljuje članom lovskih društin, ki so v minulih letih posredovali obvestila o bobnovi prisotnosti na določenem območju ali so nas obvestili o najdbah poginatih bobnov.

Verjetno se bo več dolgo, ko bomo tudi ob vodotokih na Ljubljanskem barju lahko opazili značilno ogledana debla, podeta drevesa in druge sledi dejavnosti tega največjega evropskega glodalca. O pojavljanju bobna (*Castor fiber*) na Barju imamo namreč samo neupravičena pričavanja, ki pa so, glede na nedavno širjenje po Savi, povsem verjetna. V preteklosti je bober že naseljeval območje Barja. Zname so številne najdbe bobrovih kosti z mostiščanskih naselbin. Za mostiščanje, ki so se začeli naseljevati ob Mostiščanskem jezuru nekako v petem tisočletju pred našim štetjem, je bil zelo pomemben del

Danes, ko je človek večino rečnih ekosistemov ukrotil, ko ima obrežne vegetacije domovinsko pravico le še v sami rečni brežini, ko vse več njiv meji na reko, ko urbanizacija požira obrežne ravnice, se je po letu 1998 začel vračati bober v porečju Krke, Kolpe, Sotle, Drave in Mure.

Bober postaja ključna vrsta navedenih rečnih ekosistemov. S podiranjem vegetacije, gradnjo jezov in erodiranjem brežin lokalno povečuje pestrost habitatov in naravno ohranjenost. Na odsekih v stiku z urbanim in kmetijskih zaledjem pa je njegova dejavnost pričakovano slabo sprejeta.

Zaradi nerazumevanja njegove vloge v naravi, smo ga v preteklosti že iztrebili. Pričakujemo, da bomo danes lažje sprejeli izziv sobivanja. Živeti z bobrom namreč pomeni ohranjeti večjo stopnjo naravnih procesov v obrežnem prostoru, hkrati pa tudi osvežiti pogled na ranjene rečne ekosisteme in mokrišča.

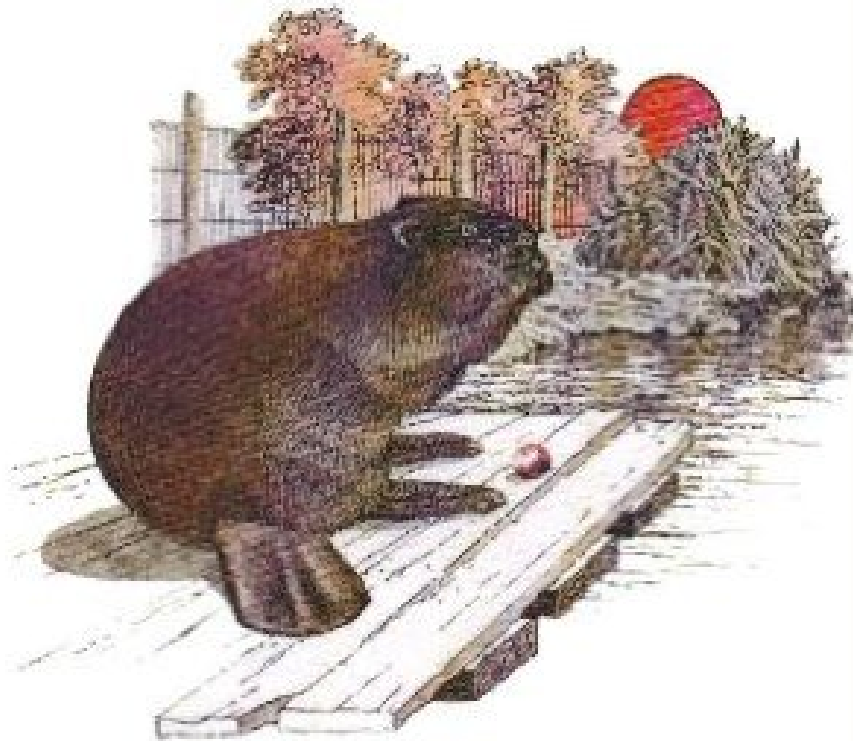

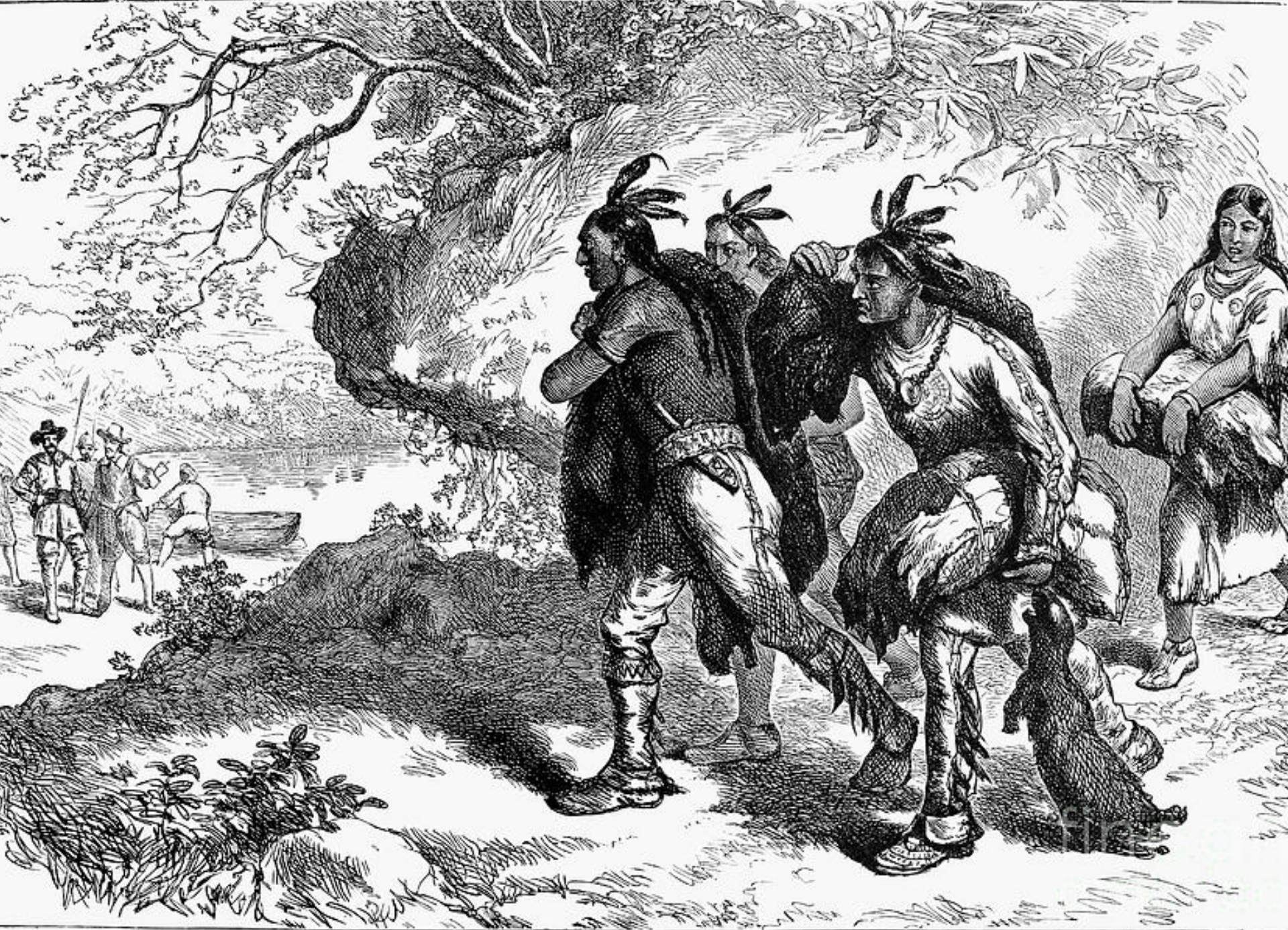

KENOSHA, Wis., Oct. 29.—The second big shipwreck on Lake Michigan within a week claimed eight lives Tuesday while coast guardsmen fought their way through mountainous waves to save 66 others from the 40 years old steamer Wisconsin after it had floundered in a storm 33 miles off the coast.

Among the rescued brought to hospital here 20 were suffering from severe injuries.

SENATOR BURTON, LONG LEADER OF OHIO POLITICS AND FRIEND OF PRESIDENT HOOVER IS DEAD

(By United Press.)
WASHINGTON, Oct. 29.—Senator Theodore E. Burton, of Ohio, for years a Republican leader and close personal friend of President Hoover, died at his home here Monday night. He was 78 years old and had been in poor health for the past year. Although confined to his home for weeks he maintained his usual interest in legislative matters and kept in close touch with his office until only a few days before his death.

Had Influenza
He suffered a seemingly mild attack of influenza about a month ago but, in his weakened condition, was unable to combat it and suffered a serious relapse last Wednesday. Bishop William T. MacDowell, of the Methodist Episcopal church, was to officiate at funeral services at the Senate chamber at 9:30 p. m. President Hoover will attend the rites. The body will be taken to Cleveland for burial.

The Senate adjourned Tuesday out of respect for Burton, whose death was called to the attention of the Senate by Senator Fess of Ohio, when that body convened. Fess presented a resolution expressing the Senate's regret at the death of the Ohio legislator and instructing Vice President Curtis to name a committee of 19 senators to take charge of the funeral and arrange

Southwest Joins in Second
Great Search in Three
Months

NEAR T. A. T. DISASTER

LOS ANGELES, Oct. 29.—The Southwest's second great air hunt within three months started at dawn Tuesday when planes took the air from Los Angeles and Albuquerque, N. M., to search for the Western Air Express passenger liner feared lost near the rugged Arizona-New Mexico state line.

Two passengers and a crew of three were aboard the plane when it took off from Kingman, Ariz., at 7:24 a. m. Monday after refueling on its flight from Los Angeles to Albuquerque. The plane was seen over Adamana and again over Navajo, Ariz. Some 200 miles west of Albuquerque, but from Navajo on its course remained a mystery.

JOHN ROACH STRATON, NOTED FUNDAMENTALIST AND PASTOR OF CALVARY CHURCH IS DEAD

(By United Press.)
NEW YORK, Oct. 29.—Dr. John Roach Stratton, noted fundamentalist minister, died at Clinton Springs, N. Y., according to word received at his residence here Tuesday. Heart disease was given as the cause of death. Stratton, pastor of the Calvary Baptist church here, had been ill for some time. His wife was at the bedside.

Renowned Elitist
The rise of Stratton in the ministry was accidental and rapid. Born in Knoxville Tenn. in 1875, he attended Morse University, and later took a professorship at Taylor University. He accepted a call to a Chicago pulpit and from there came to the Calvary Baptist church, regarded by clergymen as the most influential fundamentalist pulpit in the denomination.

Suggested Bryan
Stratton rallied to the support of William Jennings Bryan in the Scooped case at Dayton, Tenn., and was an incessant worker for state ownership of the theater. In the 1908 presidential election, he came out against Alfred E. Smith because of the latter's stand on prohibition. His plans for a 25-story combination church and hotel aroused criticism from members of

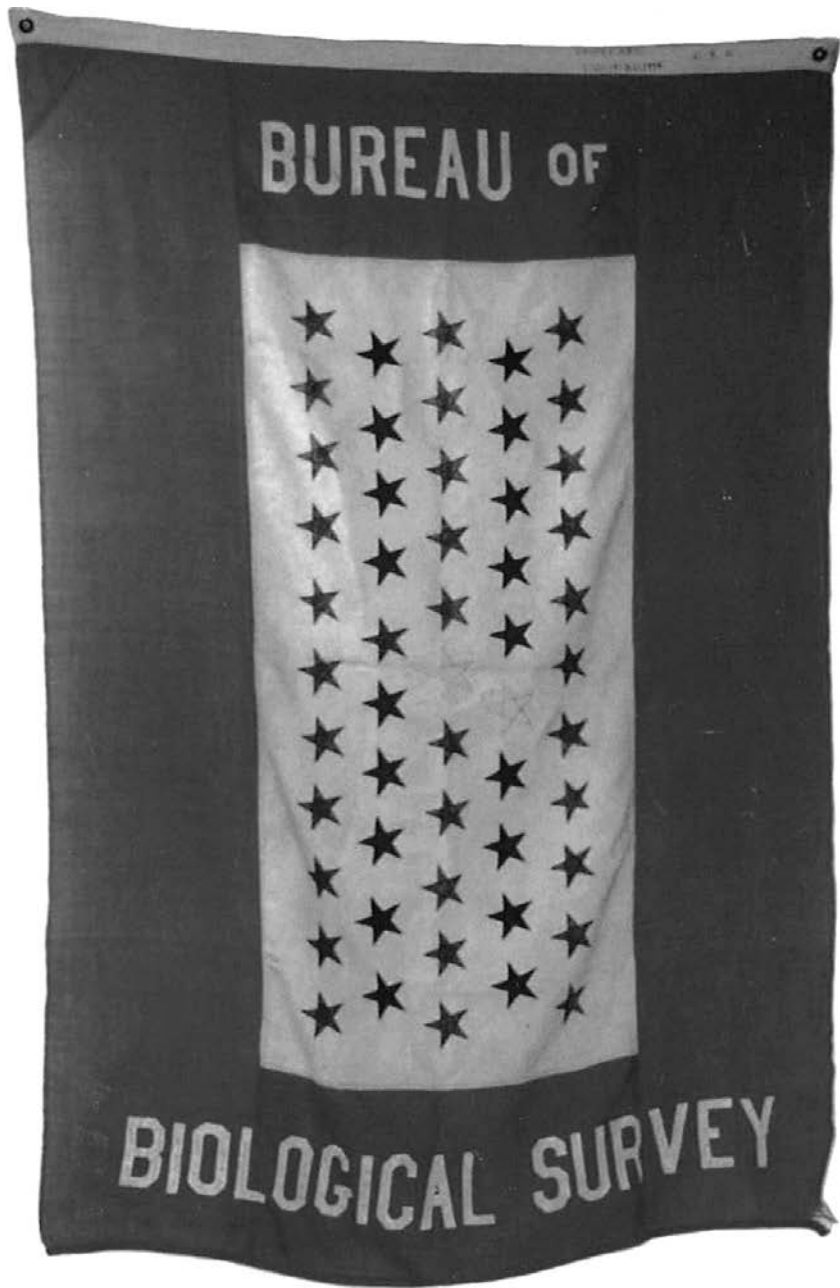




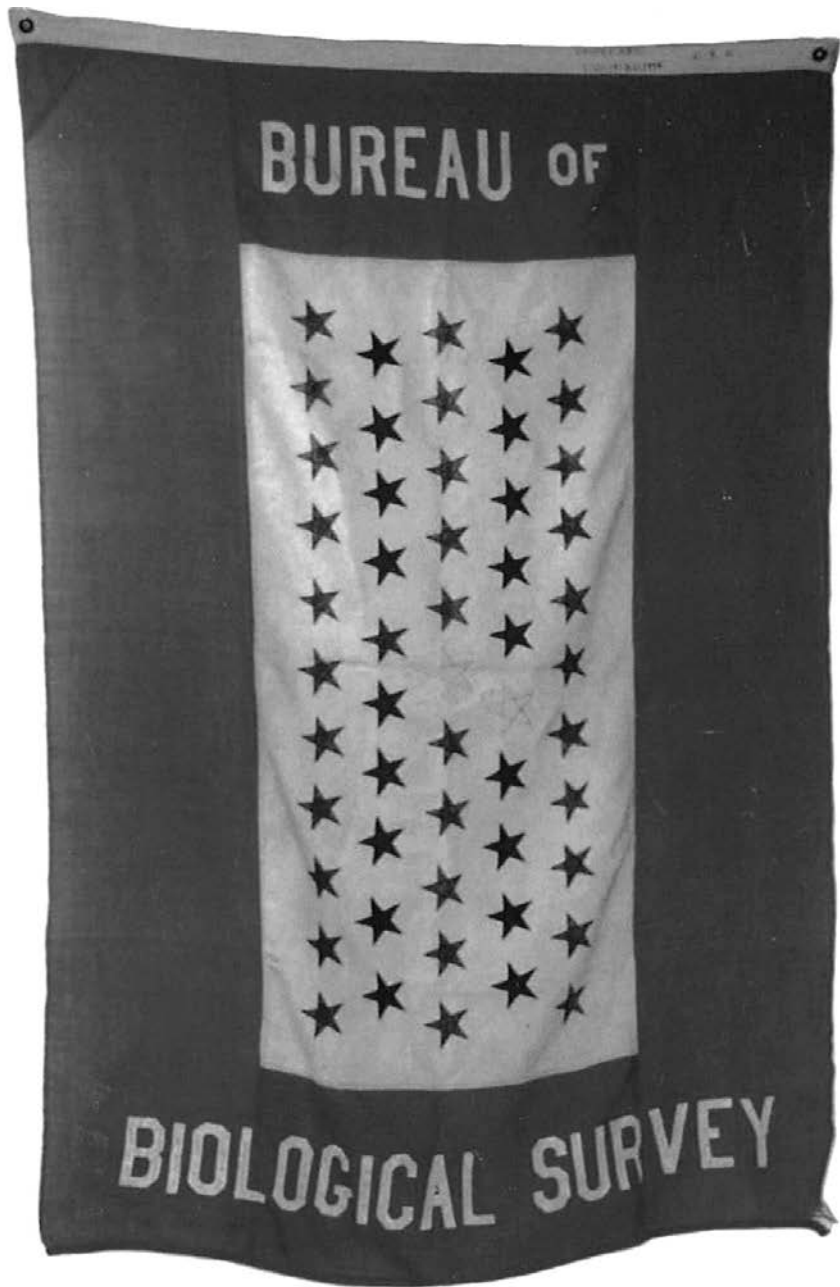

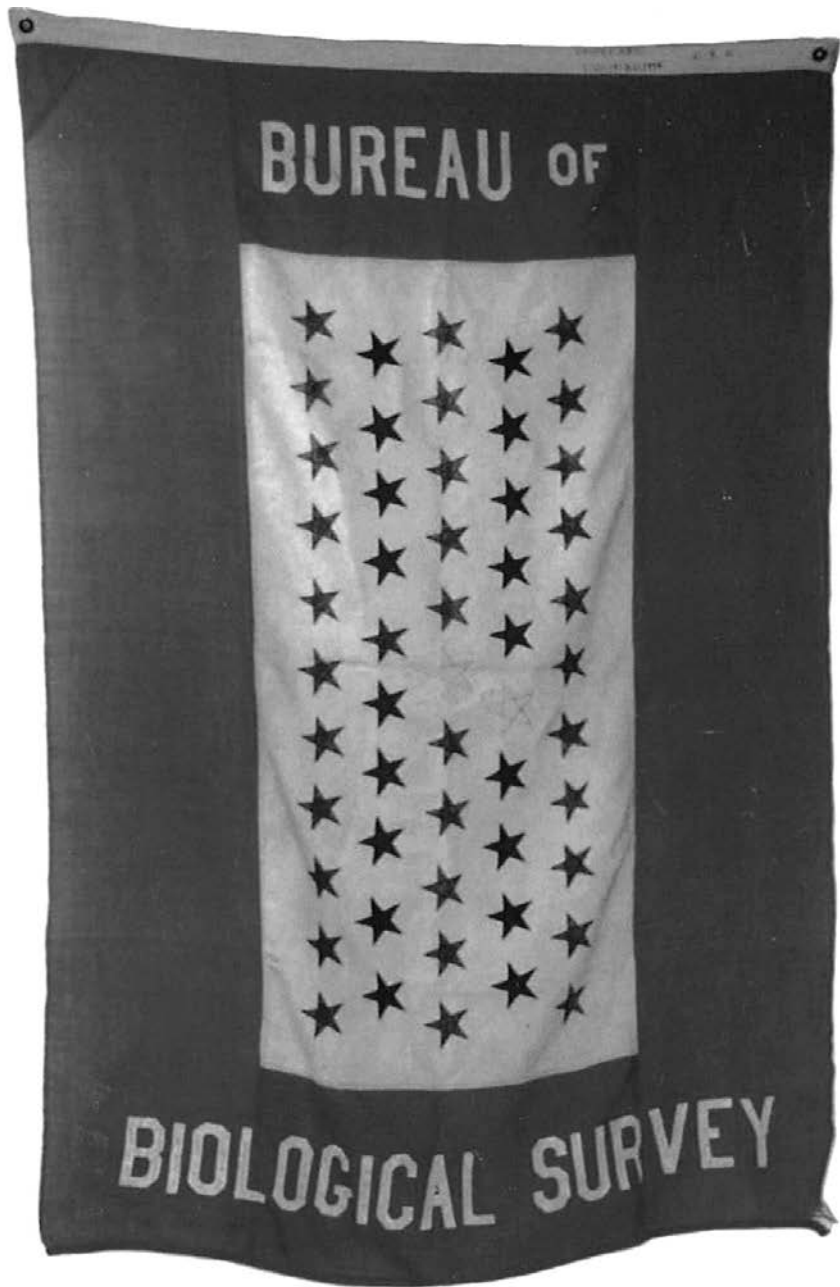

Winter is the season when the sleuths are busiest. In the photo above are shown two notorious wolves which were trailed and shot by government hunters.

“BRING him in, dead or alive!” This square-jawed sentence sounds like parting words of advice to a posse of deputy sheriffs. But in this case it does not apply to man trailers but to animal hunters. It is the slogan of the super-sleuths of Uncle Sam, now engaged in a relentless battle against a vast animal underworld with headquarters in the great Western stock country.

All through the range lands these daring and persistent men trap the wary wolf, poison the cunning coyote, and shoot the meat-hungry grizzly bear and mountain lion. Oftentimes they spend months and even years trailing a single murderer.

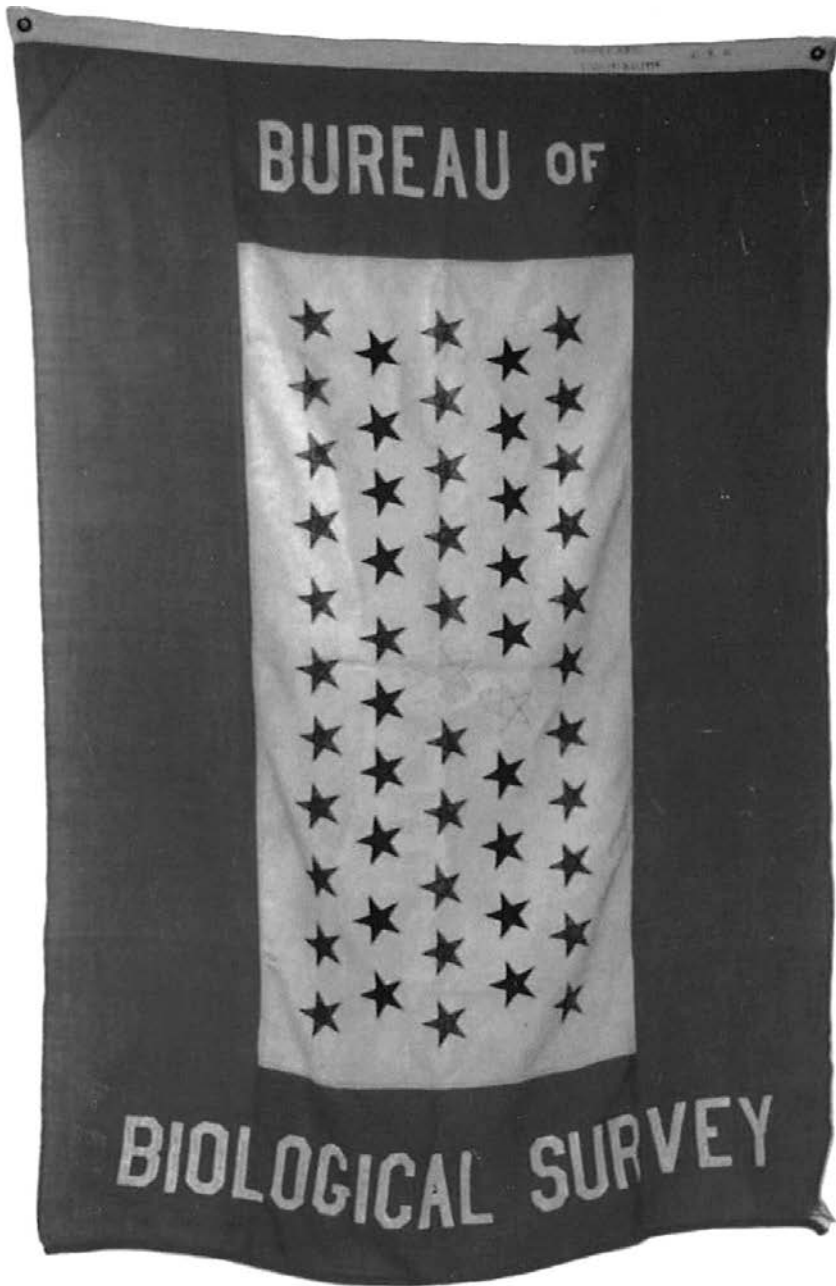
Brimful are the records of the Biological Survey with accounts of the killing of predatory animals that have made remarkable reputations for cunning and destructiveness. An Arizona grizzly, for instance, had been killing cattle every spring for 10 years, and stockmen had offered bounties for his hide
