

- Specific survival skills : First responder training, etc...
- Focus, mindset, meditation.
- First hand experiences of life on Hostile environments and Geological Landscapes similar to Mars / Moon / Asteroids. (Hymalayan Glaciers, Atacama Desert, Ojos Del Salado Volcano, High Arctic.

- 2013 : THE ARCTIC CIRCLE RESIDENCY : Arctic Ocean, Svalbard and Ny-Alesund [Northernmost Human Settlement]



- Organized by THE FARM.INC a NYC Based Cultural organization
- First French Selected
- 15 Days on a Boat in the Arctic Ocean up to 20 from the North Pole
- Exploration of previously unexplored landscapes
- groupe of 20 people including armed Guides for Polar Bears protections.
- First First-hand study of Arctic Guides and Local equipments for survival in the Arctic.
- First physical training for exploration / expeditions

- Daily live blogging for a French Newspaper with a Satellite terminal (Iridium Go) LiveTracking Map of the expedition.
- Film making for a 4 Part Documentary broadcasted on PBS
