



Target 4.c

By 2030, substantially increase the supply of qualified teachers, including through international cooperation for teacher training in developing countries, especially least developed countries and small island developing States.

While quality needs to be both understood in terms of academic and training qualifications, <u>the proposed</u> global indicator focuses on training rather than academic <u>qualification</u>

- this programme will increase the SEAMEO Centres' visibility and impact for the community development as well as further strengthen their networks in Southeast Asian countries.


