Open Educational Resources in Macedonia

- Current Situation, Challenges and Initiatives -

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Context

- Population over 2 million people
- Primary education:
 - Lasts 9 years
 - 192,715 students, 17,887 teachers
- Secondary education:
 - Lasts 3-4 years
 - 76,394 students, 7,420 teachers)
- Higher education:
 - 4,114 teachers at 19 Higher Education Institutions (Universities, Faculties, ...)
 - 58,083 enrolled students in the academic year 2016/2017
 - In 2016, a total of 2 021 persons obtained the titles of Master of Science and Specialist
 - 197 persons have gained the title "Doctor of Science" in 2016
- Internet penetration:
 - Population aged 15-74 72%
 - Internet most used by students 100%
 - 99.2% of all households with Internet access have broadband (fixed or mobile) connection to the Internet
- Textbooks for Primary and Secondary Education:
 - Free of charge


OER Policy and Regulation

- Education has a constitutional basis
- No policy and regulation on OER
- Law on Primary Education
 - a) mandatory and free of charge
 - b) public interest
 - c) IT technologies (Internet) must be used
- Law on Secondary Education
 - a) secondary education is also defined as public interest, it is mandatory and free in public high schools
- Law on Textbooks for Primary and Secondary Education
 - a) Textbooks are free of charge
 - Proposed by the Bureau for Development of Education and confirmed by the minister
- Law on Copyright and Related Rights
 - a) Defines the principles that regulate the rights of textbooks' authors, regardless the form of the textbooks printed or electronic



E-Textbooks Portal - random, fragmented

and unregulated open access to textbooks in Macedonia

- Digital e-Textbooks Library
- Absence of a comprehensive policy and procedures for its implementation and use
- No value added, just a digital copy of the existing paperback textbooks
- Randomness
- Fragmentation 'e-textbooks' is a static window, "Search" is still "Under Construction"
- It provides incomplete textbooks
- No use of Creative Commons
- Authors have heard but do not really know much about the open access (OA) to textbooks
- MoE must lead towards OA and OE

Metamorphosis – the biggest supporter and initiator











- OER in Macedonia Raising awareness (academic community)

Initiatives

- Declaration on OER in Macedonia (Based on the Paris Declaration) in cooperation with the National Commission for UNESCO of Macedonia.
- Web application (http://oer.mk/sign/index.php/pages/signup)
- Round Tables with participants from primary and secondary schools, universities, libraries, nongovernmental organizations and public institutions.
- Discussions with the Government (MON, MIOA, MOC) on OER cooperation, and preparation for the law amendments. Raising awareness among government officials.
- Production and distribution of promotional material (Video Clip (http://oer.mk/sign/index.php/pages/video/)
 brochures, leaflets, t-shirts and mobile phone holders with personalized messages (And Name supports OER, too.)

Challenges and Future Plans

- OE and OER Sustainability (through introduction of the OE and OER into the Law on Textbooks, and other Edu-Laws).
- OER Alliance in Macedonia to become more recognizable and with more members (1000 individuals, 50 organizations).
- Cooperation with Metamorphosis and other promoters and supporters if possible.
- Continue and intensify discussions with the Government and establish partnership.
- Continue Raising Awareness especially among Government and Ministries, Universities, Research Centers, Business Sector (Lifelong learning, On-the-job training) and introduce more innovative approach.
