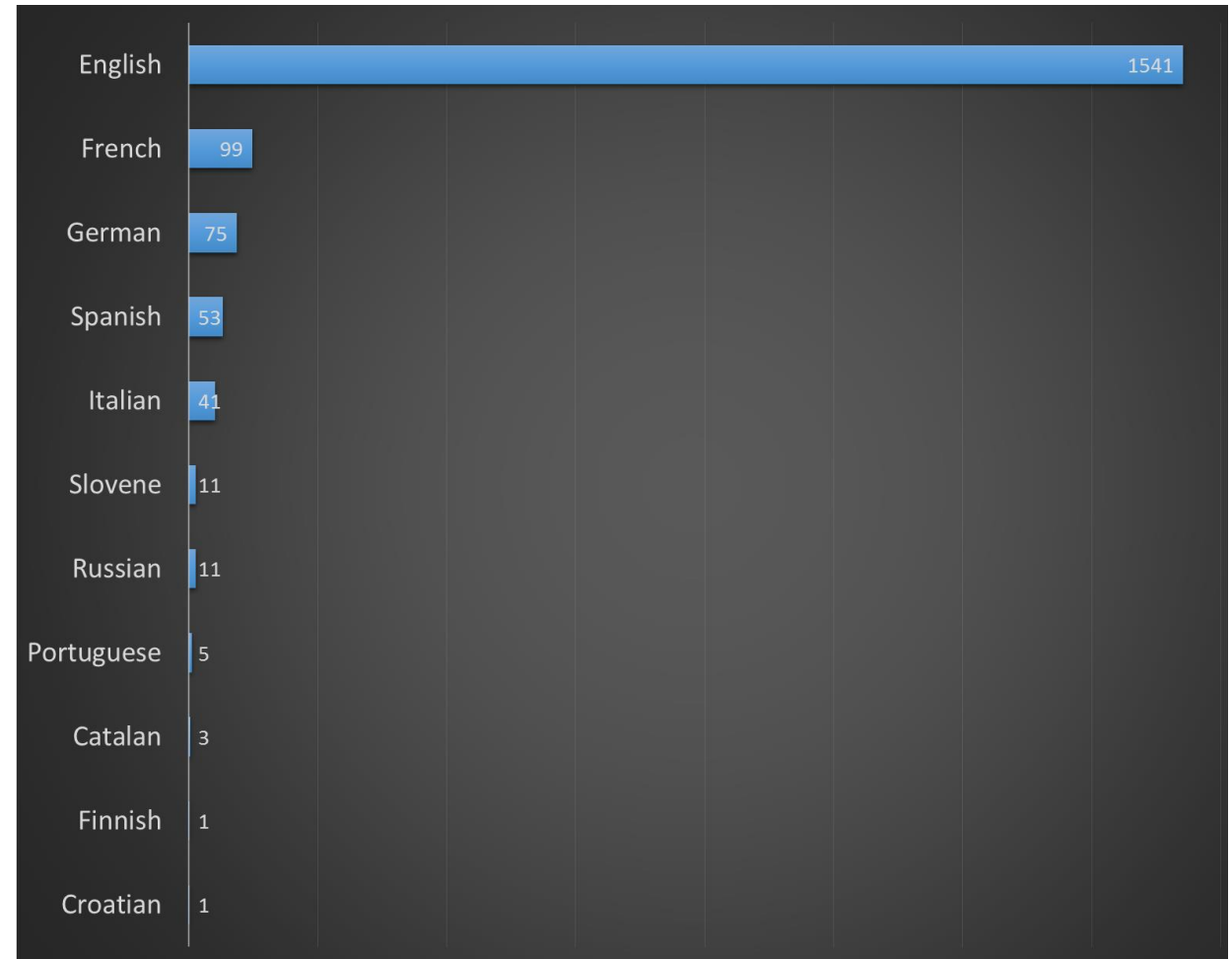


# ELEXIS objectives
