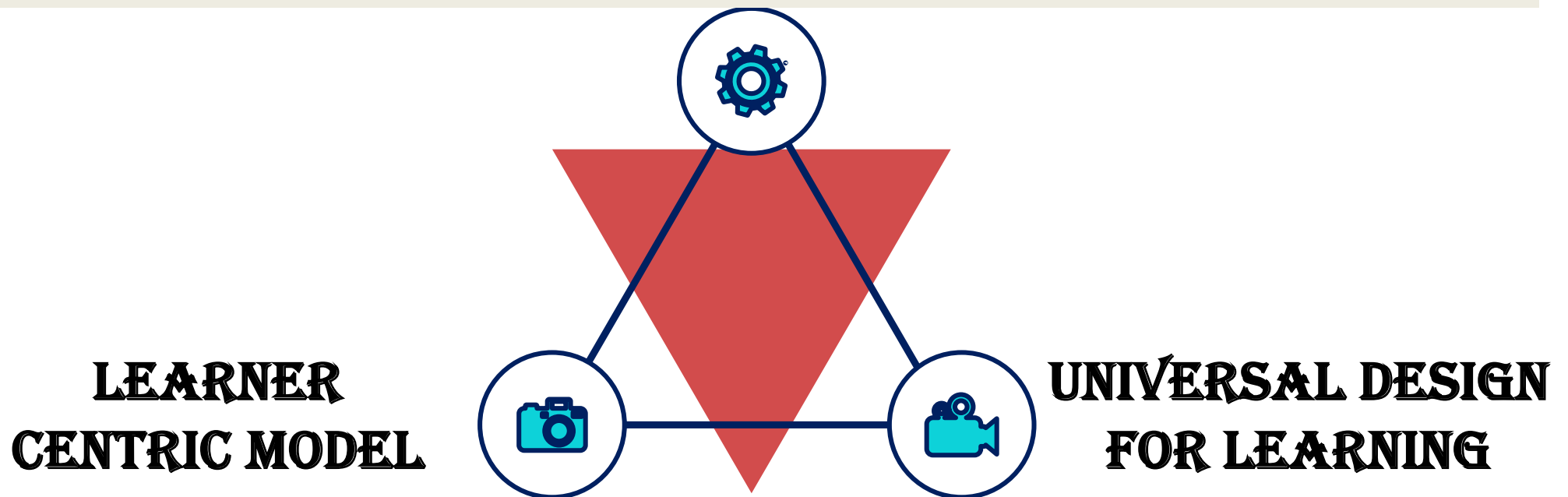

To provide learners a deeper understanding of licensing under Creative Commons and obtaining ISBN number for writings without any payment of fee.

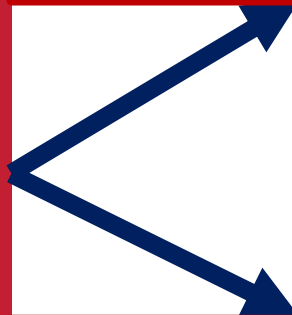

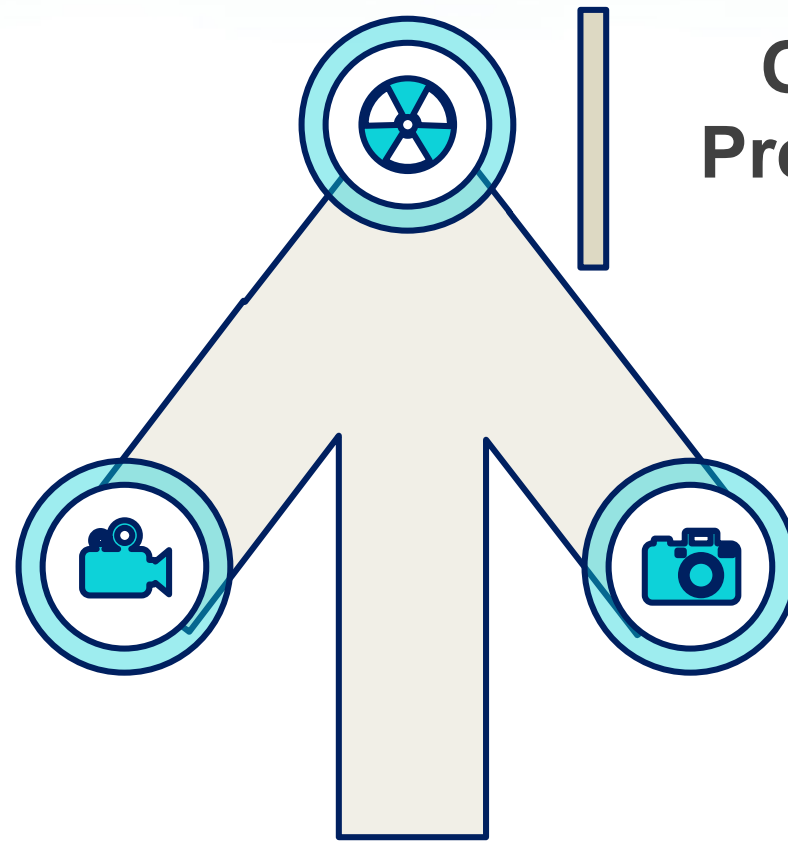
