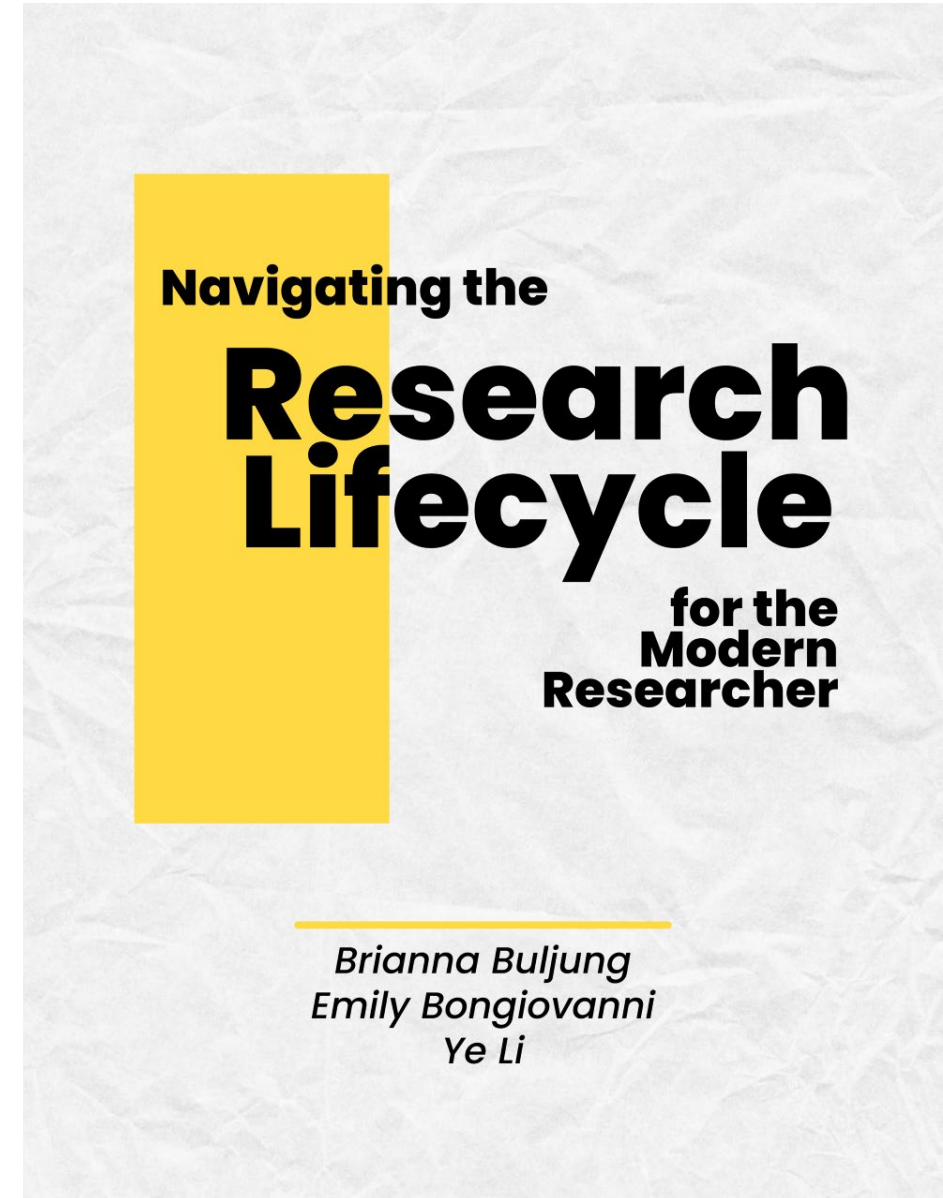

Contents:

- 14 chapters in 4 sections

- Walks through research lifecycle linearly but chapters can be revisited or skipped

Early Feedback

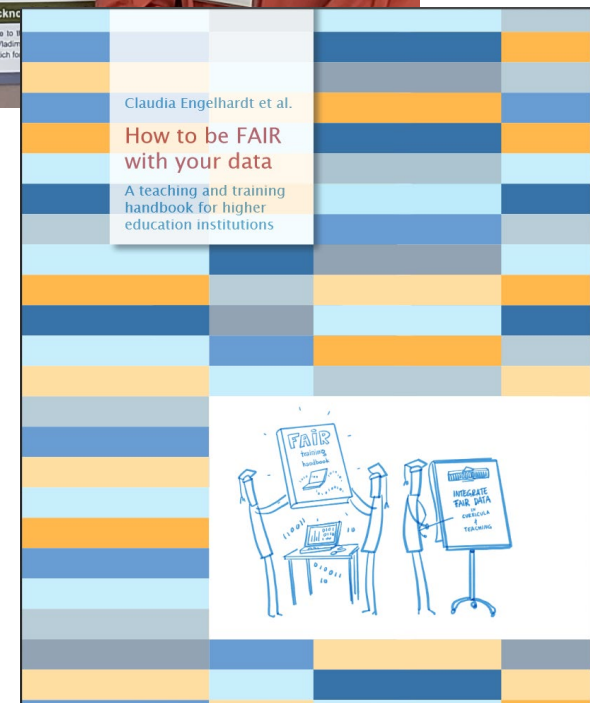
Presented poster at the 2022 LIBER Annual Conference in Odense, Denmark
