## Science 2.0?

The world of scientific publications has been largely oblivious to the advent of the Web ....

- Scientific knowledge dissemination is still based on the traditional notion of "paper" publication and on peer review as quality assessment method.
- The current approach encourages authors to write many (possibly incremental) papers to get more "tokens of credit", generating often unnecessary dissemination overhead for themselves and for the community of reviewers.
- Furthermore, it does not encourage or support reuse and evolution of publications: whenever a (possibly small) progress is made on a certain subject, a new paper is written, reviewed, and published, often after several months.
