- Information value is not
 - Static
 - Absolute
 - (always) Individual



Social Media

- Relationships are not
 - Discrete
 - Fixed
 - Explicit



Social Media

- Interactions, transfer, and effect vary in
 - Meaning
 - Content
 - Scope



Main Research Questions

- Information value: beyond information theory
- Social structure: culture and context dependent
- Interaction, transfer, and effect: much deeper analysis of human-human communications

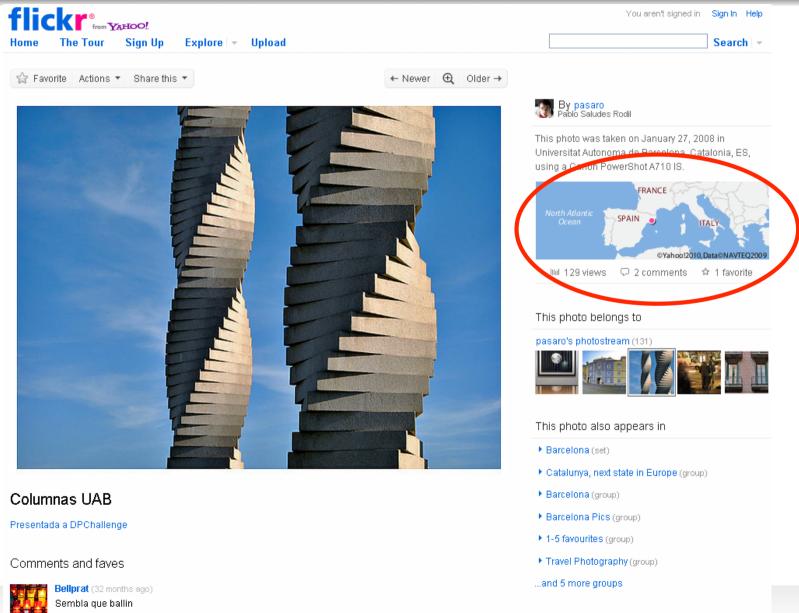

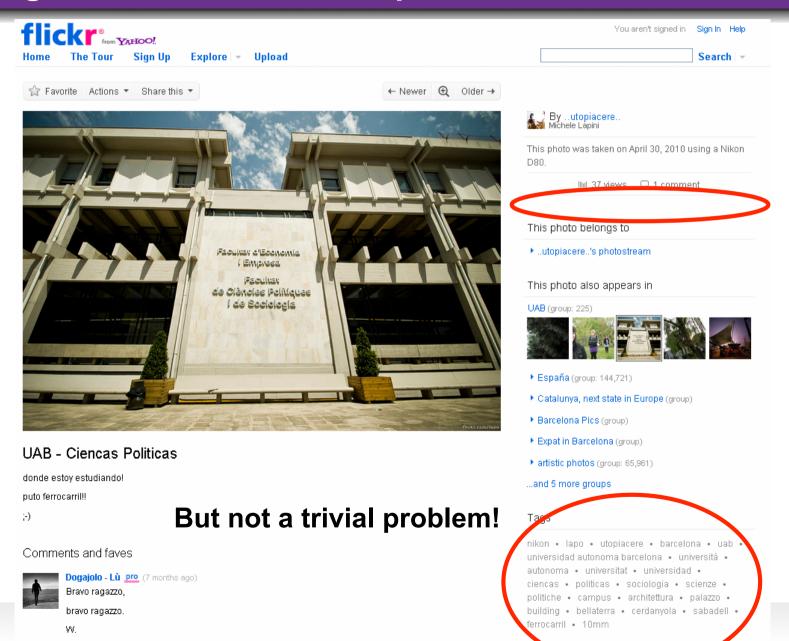
Further Motivation

 - Information spreading models





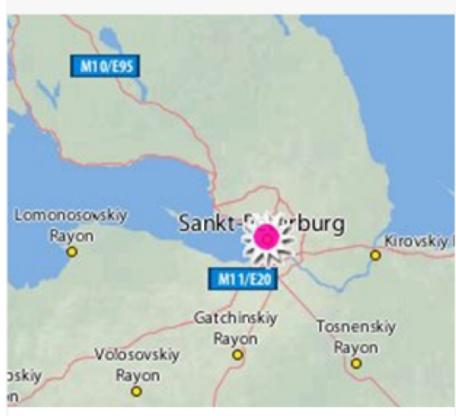

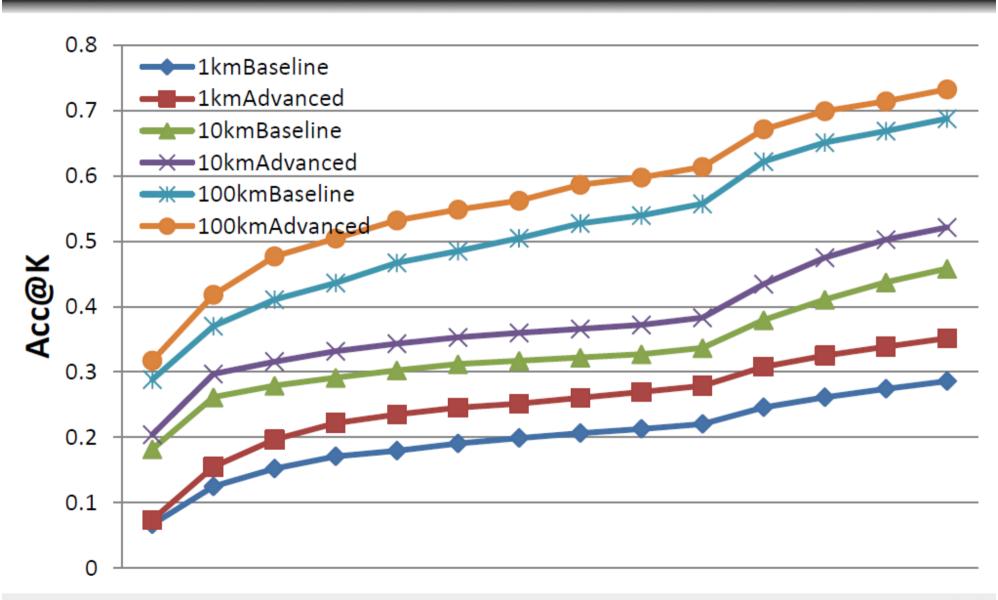

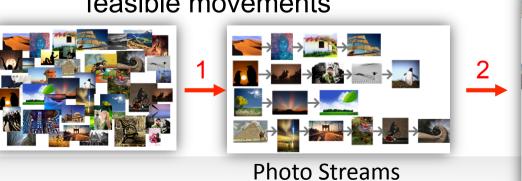
Automatic Construction of Travel Itineraries using Social Breadcrumbs

 Goal: construct intra-city travel itineraries automatically by tapping a latent source reflecting geo-temporal breadcrumbs left by tourists: Flickr

Approach

- Extract photo streams of individual users (1)
- Associate points of interest with the photos (2)
- Using the timestamps of the photos, determine:
 - Lower bounds on the amount of time spent at a PO
 - Upper bounds on the transit time between POIs

aggregate all user photo streams into a POI graph (3); apply the
 Orienteering algorithm to construct itineraries reflecting popular and feasible movements

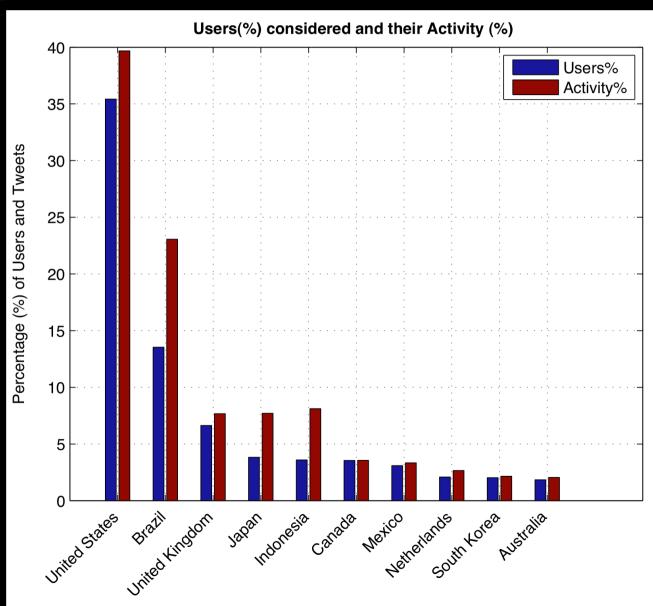

Microblogging Behavior

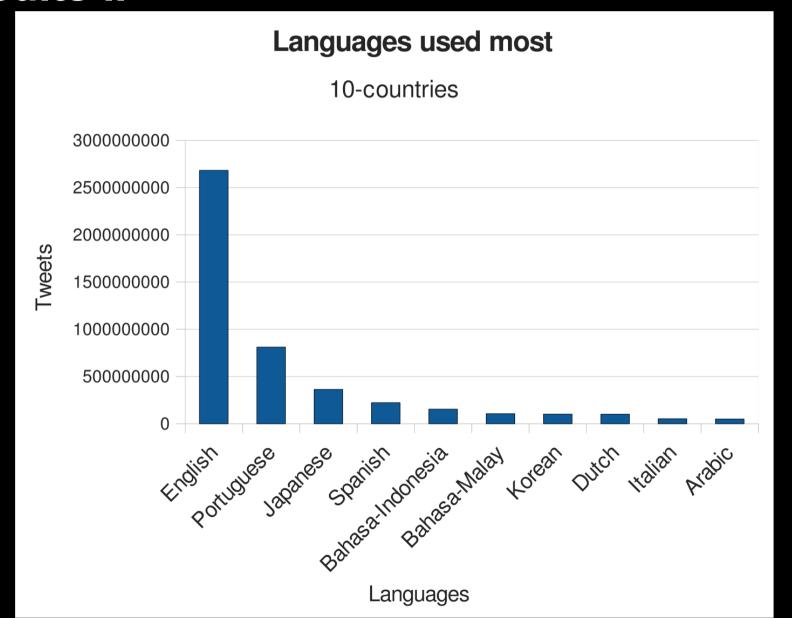
[A. Jaimes, R. Garcia, B. Poblete, M. Mendoza, ACM WebSci '11]

- 550 M tweets examined over a period of 9 days (76 M users)
 - Location information extracted
- All tweets for one year, for 10 most active countries
 - 4.7 M users, 5.2 Billion tweets

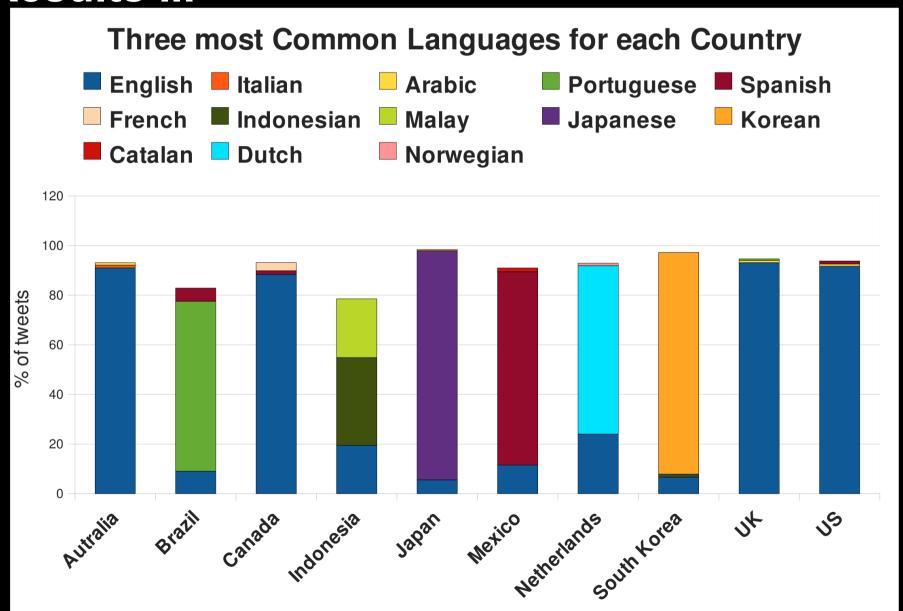

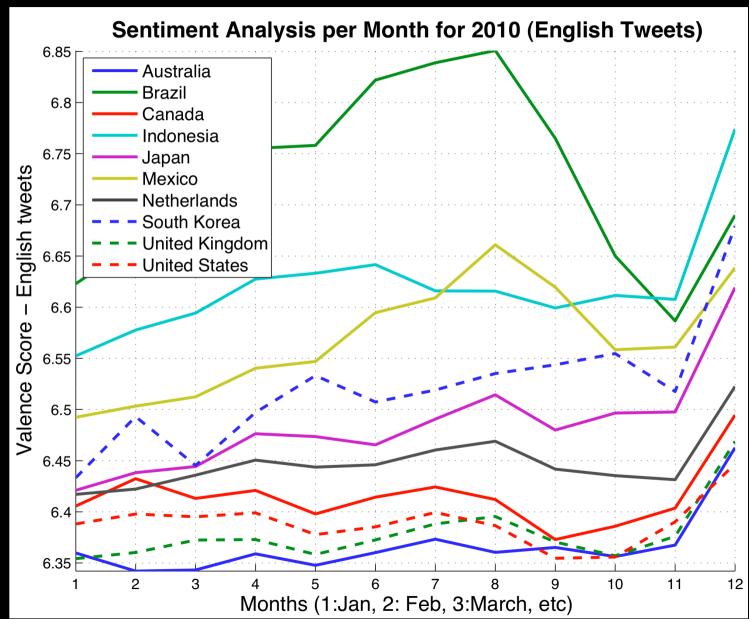

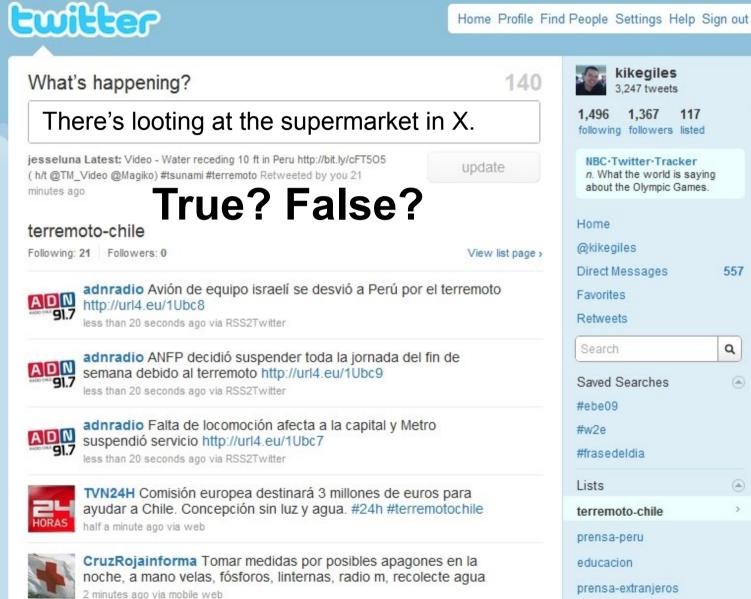

Twitter helped, but ...

- Large majority of tweets were very helpful
- Some tweets were not
 - False tsunami warnings
 - False reports of looting

A "small" earthquake in Chile

- Sat Feb 27, 2010. 03:34 local time
- 7th largest recorded in history
 - 8.8 Mw, 90 s, 500-600 casualties
 - Haiti: 7.7 Mw, 60 s, 90k-300k casualties
- Communications
 - Almost impossible for 2-3 hours
 - First video images 6-7 hours after quake







Chileans love Twitter

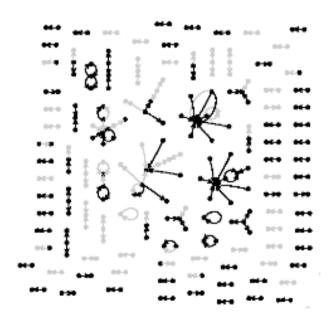
- Prominent role for communications

 - Since ~1yr before earthquake (elections)

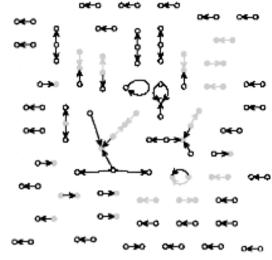

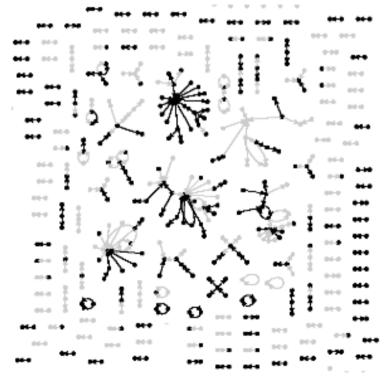

Information credibility

- Perceived quality
- Made of multiple dimensions
- Examples:
 - Same article written by male/female author
 - Same headline in news/twitter
 - ...



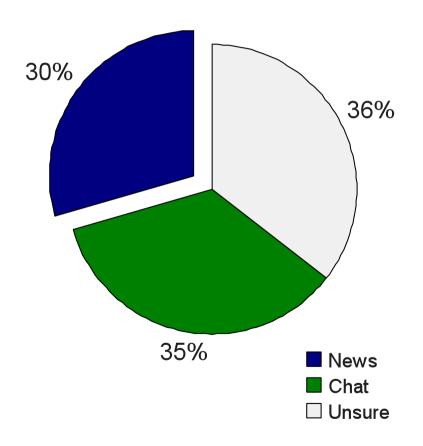
Supervised classification

- Events (tweet sets) from TwitterMonitor
 - [Mathioudakis & Koudas 2010]
- Labels from Amazon's Mechanical Turk
- Decision trees



Labeling: News or Chat

- 383 events from TwitterMonitor.net [Mathioudakis & Koudas]
- 7 evaluators per event
- >=5 agreement

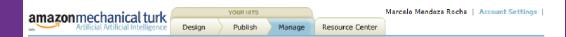

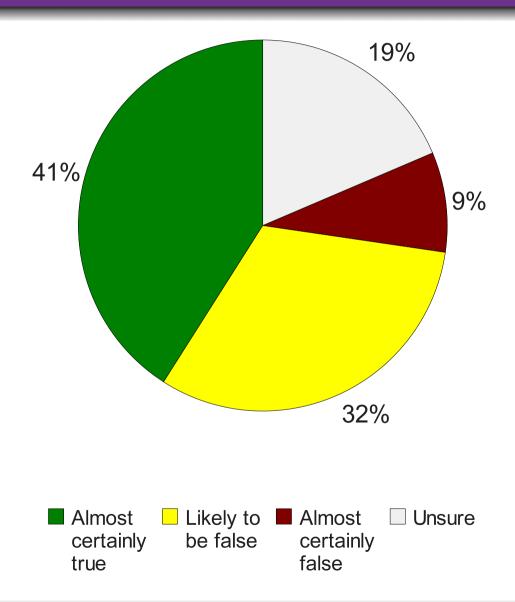

- Users believed these
- US construction plunges
 10%
- Tropical storm in the gulf
- Markets down on Portugal, Greece
- Yankees' Bob Sheppard dies

- Users did not believe these
- Lennon lyrics auctioned for 1.2m (true)
- Suspicious vehicle causes NYC scare (false alarm: no bomb was found, they were gas canisters)
- Free video calling app for Android (spam)
- Warnings on BART murder trial veredict (partially true: no widespread riots)



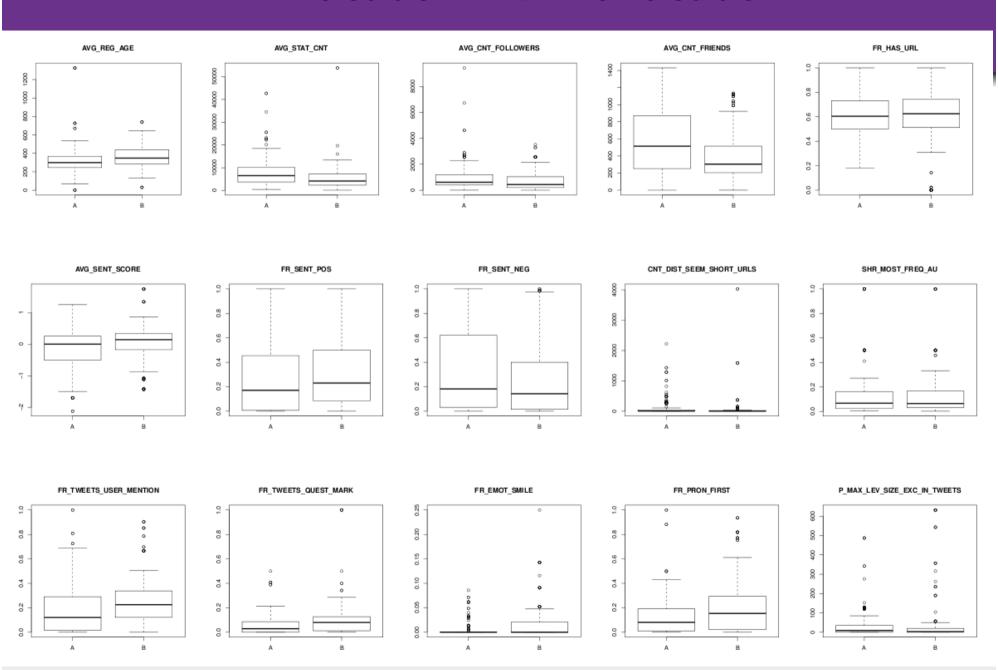
Credible tweets for users tend to ...

- Have a URL
- Don't have exclamation marks
- Express a negative sentiment
- Are re-posted by prolific users
- Are re-posted by well-connected users

Summary

- Detected <u>past</u> events on twitter
- Took a sample of 10 tweets per event
- Asked users if they believe the tweets
- Built an automatic classifier
- Got 86% accuracy on balanced classes
