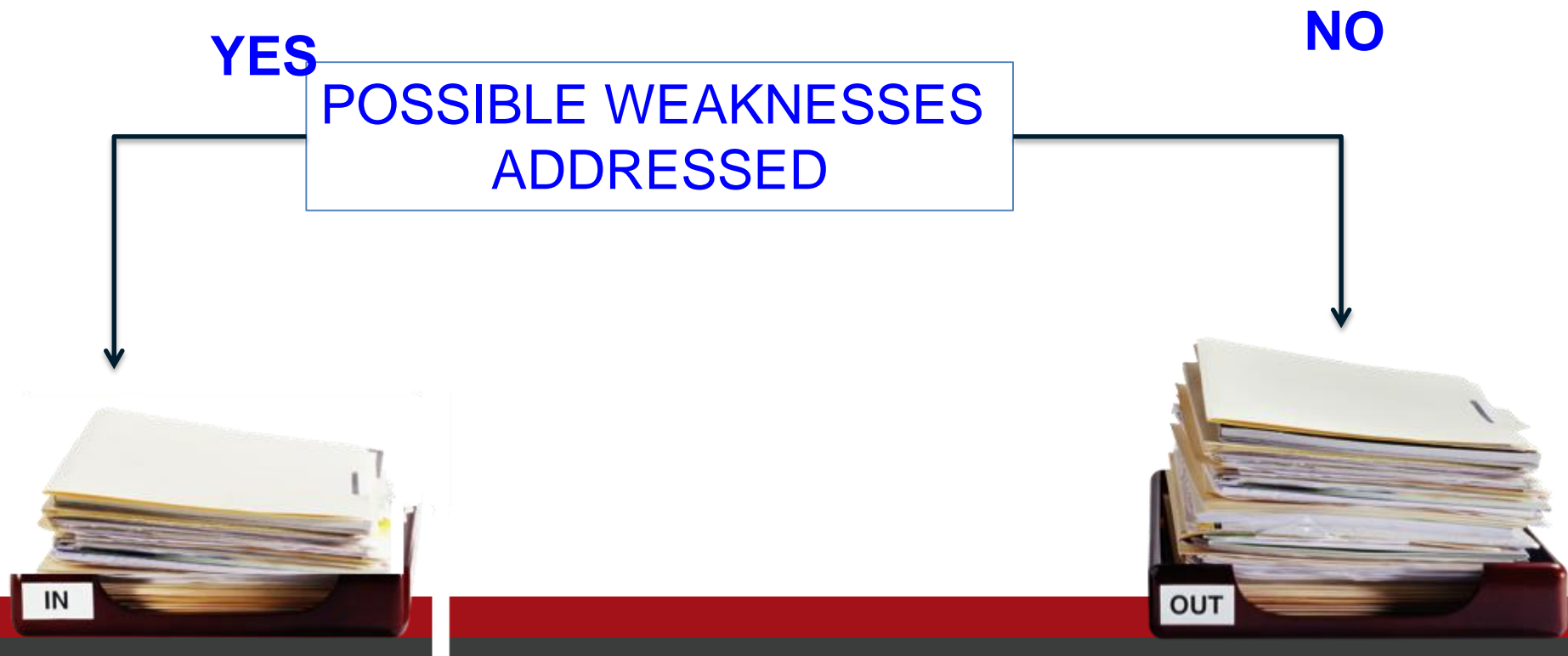

PRESENTATION

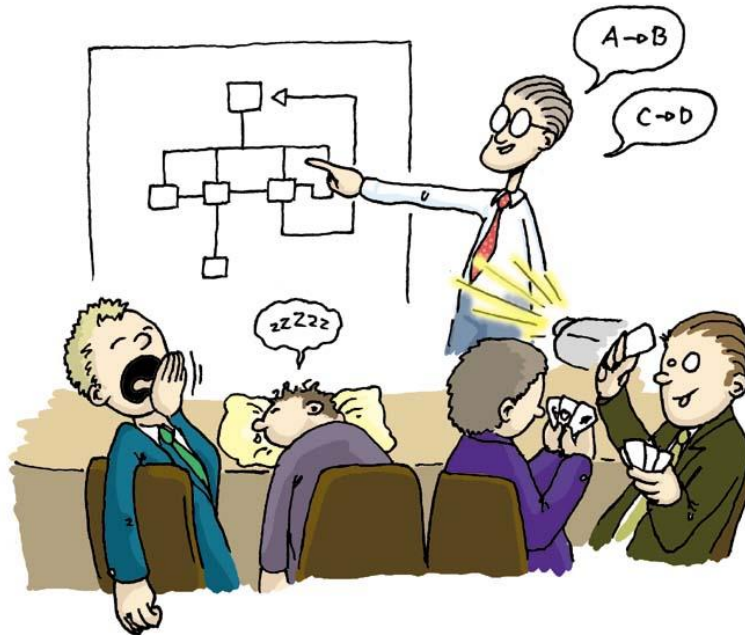
POTENTIAL IMPACT
