Definitions

 Laboratory: Data collected in a laboratory, usually following a protocol.

Found: Data obtained opportunistically

Designed: Data collected to answer a question

Undesigned: Generally for exploratory analysis

- Until about ten years ago, virtually all publicly available face and gesture data sets were collected in a laboratory.
- The Labeled Faces in the Wild (LFW) data set popularized data sets from the web.
